The major in **Kinesiology for Teachers of Physical and Health Education, grades K-12**, (State code: MC) consists of a minimum of 45 credits. The teacher candidate will complete student teaching in both Elementary and Secondary P.E. and Health settings.

Teacher candidates for certification in Kinesiology at the Secondary level must pass the Michigan Test for Teacher Certification (MTTC) in Physical and Health Education (Test #113). There are two different components to the exam (physical education and health education), both of which must be passed in order to receive certification. Exams should not be taken until 90% of course work in the subject area has been completed.

The courses below meet State standards and have been selected so that teacher candidates will be well prepared for the test. Knowledge must be demonstrated in the following categories in order to successfully pass the MTTC subject area exam:
